

## Make your character to earn the Characters Have Traits achievement

Characters in games each have their own individual traits that make them unique. Some games will track traits like skills, alignment, level, and experience points. Traits like experience points can grow during the game as your character faces challenges.

Just like characters in games, you have traits that change over the course of your life. Think about how you can express your best traits as you create a character from a paper roll.

### 1. Design the Character's Body:

- Choose a color of construction paper that you want to use as the character's body.
- Wrap the paper around the toilet paper roll, leaving a small overlap, and cut off the excess.
- Use glue or double-sided tape to secure the paper to the roll.

#### 2. Add Character Details:

- Use markers, colored pencils, or crayons to draw the character's face on the front of the roll.
- Draw or cut out additional features like arms, legs, hair, ears, or accessories from craft paper and attach them to the character's body using glue or tape.

#### 3. Personalize the Character:

 Use markers, colored pencils, or crayons to add details and personal touches to the character's body. You can also use decorative materials like pipe cleaners, feathers, sequins, buttons, or any other craft supplies to enhance the character's appearance.

#### 4. Fill in the Character Sheet

- Fill out the stats on the next page to represent your character's progress in the game of life.
- For each trait, write a number from 1 to 5, with 1 being the weakest and 5 being the strongest
